Where: Cataract Activity Centre – Baden Powell Drive, Appin.

**Inclusions:** The cost of the camp includes:

- Return travel to and from Cataract Activity Centre by a seat belted coach.
- Lunch, Afternoon Tea, Dinner and Dessert (Day 1)
- Hot Breakfast, Morning Tea and Lunch (Day 2)
- Accommodation: Air-conditioned lodges (6 beds per room)
