# Oran Park Public School

## Site establishment notification September 2018

### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

### Oran Park Public School

A project is underway to upgrade the existing Oran Park Public School to accommodate 1,000 students. The project will deliver:

- 24 new future-focused classrooms to accommodate 1,000 students
- An upgrade to administration and staff areas
- A larger covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- Additional student amenities and landscaping

These upgrades are being coordinated with the delivery of the new Oran Park High School.

### Construction contract awarded

The construction contract has been awarded to Hindmarsh Construction Pty Ltd.

### Site establishment starts 24 September 2018

Site establishment prepares the construction area so that construction works can begin.

As part of the site establishment, Hindmarsh will:

- erect construction fencing
- install the site office and work sheds
- deliver equipment

These works will take place on Monday – Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturdays from 8am – 1pm. No night works are scheduled for this project.

Site signage will be in place and hoarding put up to minimise noise and ensure the safety of the local community.
